## Rationale – Paragraph #1 (\_\_\_\_ / 20 points)

- Clearly explains purpose of the final project
- Analyzes the credibility of sources
- Describes the audience and how the project was catered to them
- Discusses the solutions that were addressed
- Describes the call to action

## Presentation – Paragraph #2 (\_\_\_\_ / 10 points)

- Clearly explains the components of a strong presentation with examples
- Clearly explains the characteristics of strong presenter with examples
- Analyzes the group's strengths and weaknesses while presenting
- ~3-4 sentences

## Future Implications – Paragraph #3 (\_\_\_\_ / 10 points)

- Describes the skills learned as part of this project
- Discusses how these skills might be applied to future classes and projects
- ~4-6 sentences

## Reflection – Paragraph #4 (\_\_\_\_ / 10 points)

- Analyzes what went well throughout the research project and describes using examples
- Analyzes what didn't go so well and describes using examples
- For each negative, a suggestion or alternative is provided
- ~4-6 sentences

## Advice for 7<sup>th</sup> Graders – Paragraph #5 (\_\_\_\_ / 10 points)

- Meaningful and helpful advice is given to 7<sup>th</sup> graders
- ~4-6 sentences

## Mechanics (\_\_\_\_ / 10 points)

- Written in MLA format – double-spaced with proper headings
- Proofread for grammatical and spelling errors
